The current generator would not be able to be used at the Glen Ullin School in a disaster situation. Shawn Dzuik amended the motion to include that salaries be rounded up to the nearest dollar. Motion unanimously carried.

Shawn Dziuk motioned to raise adult hot lunch price to \$3.75 and adult breakfast price to \$2.90 for the 2019-2020 school year, seconded by, Matt Miller. Motion unanimously carried.

- **6-D) Staffing for 19-20:** Marie Bittner made a motion, seconded by Shawn Dziuk, to approve the resignation of Kayla Tatro as elementary teacher. Motion unanimously carried.

Matt Miller made a motion, seconded by Travis Thomas, to approve the resignation of Monica Goven as VoAg instructor. Motion unanimously carried.

Carrie Gerving made a motion, seconded by Shawn Dziuk, to approve to hire Taylor Petersen as an Elementary Teacher for the 19-20 school year. Motion unanimously carried.

- **6-G)** Review of School Insurance: Mr. Barry gave the board information regarding the current insurance policy. Shawn Dziuk made a motion, seconded by Travis Thomas, to approve an increase of \$1.00 a day for the bus drivers. Motion unanimously carried.

Carrie Gerving made a motion, seconded by Travis Thomas, to approve the Preschool Program for the 19-20 school year. Motion unanimously carried.

Shawn Dziuk made a motion, seconded by Marie Bittner, to approve to hire Mariah Thiel as Preschool Teacher for the 19-20 school year. Motion unanimously carried.

Sealed Bids: President Lisa Gerving opened the sealed bids. A motion was made by Carrie Gerving, seconded by, Travis Thomas to accept the top bid of \$505.00 from Dallas Schaaf for the 1997 school bus. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Shawn Dziuk, seconded by, Travis Thomas to accept the top bid of \$500.00 from Daryl Steckler for the lawn tractor. Motion unanimously carried.
