- **B. ACTIVITY BUS:** Superintendent Barry presented bid information from Vendors. After the board viewed the information, Carrie Gerving moved, seconded by Matt Kuhn, to purchase an Activity Bus from Harlow's Bus and to add air-conditioning for no more than \$10,000.00. The bus will be paid one-half from the 2015 Fiscal year budget and one-half from the 2016 Fiscal year budget. Motion unanimously carried.
- C. FACILITIES UPDATE: Superintendent Barry reported on the progress of projects being worked on: updating the shop, fire alarm system, lighting, water fountain, and digital sign.

D. OPEN CORSICA BIDS: No bids were submitted for the 1990 Corsica. After discussion as how to dispose of the vehicle, Matt Kuhn offered to pay \$200.00 for the Corsica. Carrie Gerving moved, seconded by Lisa Gerving, to sell the 1990 Corsica to Matt Kuhn for \$200.00. All members voted yes except Matt Kuhn who subsided from voting. Motion carried

- **A. SUMMER SCHOOL AND SUMMER BLAST:** Superintendent Barry gave an update on the upcoming summer activities.
- **B. STAFFING FOR 2015-16:** Lisa Gerving moved, seconded by Sandra Gerving, to approve to increase John Barry's salary 5,000.00 and to increase Peter Remboldt's salary \$4,000.00 for the 2015-16 school year. Motion unanimously carried.
- **C. BUDGET & FINANCE UPDATE:** Superintendent Barry gave an update on the Legislation Session.
- **D. IDEA:** Mr. Barry reported information on the "Individual with Disabilities Education Act" status.
- **E. AFM:** Shawn Dziuk moved, seconded by Matt Kuhn, to increase the salary of the Adult Farm Management Instructor, Donald Hagen, by 3.5% for the 2015-2016 school year. Motion unanimously carried.
- F. ELECTION WORKERS: Carrie Gerving moved, seconded by Lisa Gerving, to allow the Business Manager to hire Judges and Clerks for the School Board Election on June 9, 2015. Motion unanimously carried.
- **G. PRESCHOOL HANDBOOK:** Matt Kuhn moved, seconded by Carrie Gerving to approve the clarification of the Preschool Handbook. Motion unanimously carried.
- H. FRUIT AND VEGETABLE PROGRAM: Superintendent Barry informed the board that the Glen Ullin School was awarded a Grant of \$6,000.00 for the Fruit and Vegetable Program for the 2015-16 school year.
- I. **IMMUNIZATION RECORDS:** Information was given on the number of students immunized in the Glen Ullin School District.
